- Teaching techniques for promoting cultural dialogue, identifying the learning needs of adult migrants, recognizing the educational cultures of adult migrants, encouraging learners' orientation and participation in the learning process, etc.
- Teaching techniques for promoting tolerance, equality, diversity and inclusion in the learning process of adult migrants
- Teaching techniques for application of interactive and attractive language teaching methods and products with intercultural elements and video demonstrations for making the learning process more attractive and encouraging participation
