Recognized as a public utility since 1875, Aurore draws on its experience to offer and experiment with innovative forms of taking charge, which adapts to the evolution of phenomena of precariousness and exclusion. The association works in partnership with the state, local authorities, regions, departments and municipalities. Its activities are numerous and important, particularly on social and professional reintegration. Its multidisciplinary approach mobilizes the skills of the association in the health, social, training or integration fields. Teams are constantly looking for innovation to better respond to new forms of exclusion.</p>
