Social and linguistic barriers, the lack of networking, the nonrecognition of their qualifications and experiences, the lack of awareness of the market, are all making difficult the pursuit of their careers in their host country. Often employed in so-called voltage sectors (security, cleaning, construction), these choices by default lead to a rupture of their career path and a loss of self-esteem. |
